A year has passed since our last mailout so there is a lot to tell. A whole series of NO-MAN and related releases is scheduled for the latter half of 1999 and early next year. These will include reissues of One Little Indian era material, other archive recordings and culminate in the (much delayed) new album "Lighthouse" in early 2000.

SPEAK

Italian label Materiali Sonori has just issued the NO-MAN CD "Speak". Previously only available on cassette, these songs dating from 1988-91 have now been partly re-recorded and remixed for a CD issue, along with other material from the same period. Track listing is:

THE SKY GOES ALL THE WAY HOME

NO-MAN appear on a new 35 track double CD charity compilation called "The Sky Goes All The Way Home". The album released through Voiceprint also features exclusive recordings from Robert Fripp and Peter Hammill among others. The NO-MAN track is called "Like a Child" and is a reconstruction of "Close Your Eyes" from last year's "Carolina Skeletons" EP.

RADIO SESSIONS CD

Over the last 5 years, the band have frequently been asked to re-issue the Hit the North 1992 radio session (featuring the 1992 touring band which included Jansen, Barbieri and Karn) on CD. Tim and Steven were never happy enough with this performance to make it a full blown commercial release, but have decided to make the session the centrepiece of a whole disc of session recordings that will only be sold via mail order from the NO-MAN address for a very limited period.

Please note that the discs will be made to order using a CD writer and will not have any artwork apart from a basic insert listing the tracks, dates and line ups. The disc runs for over 70 minutes and features 16 tracks from 5 separate session recordings between 1992 and 1996. The sonic quality is excellent throughout.

Hidden Art

Hidden Art has been reactivated and the first 2 new releases are the second album by Steven's ambient project Bass Communion and an album by Tim Bowness in collaboration with Cambridge band Samuel Smiles. Bass Communion's self-titled second release continues where the first left off, creating a distinctive and emotionally resonant electro-organic fusion of ambient loop music, minimalism and darkly evocative textures. Tim's album with Samuel Smiles (Michael Bearpark guitar, Peter Chilvers - piano, Myke Clifford sax/flute), 'World Of Bright Futures' is an atmospheric blend of singer-songwriter intimacy and textural experiment which in some ways is a natural extension of Tim's work with Richard Barbieri on 1994's 'Flame'. The first pressing of both albums come with an extra disc of bonus material.
